IMPORTANT SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

1. All applications must be filled out completely and returned to the Recording Secretary of Division 10, AOH, 105 Federal St. Lynn, MA. 01905 **no later than April 15th**.
2. An official transcript of grades received during the last four years of the applicant's school years, whether they are in Middle School, High School or College.
3. A letter stating the reason they are applying for the Hibernian Scholarship must be included with the application and the transcripts.
4. All of the above instructions must be carried out so the application of the candidate can be considered.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Applicants for the Hibernian Scholarships shall be the son /daughter, stepson/ stepdaughter, grandson/granddaughter of a **FULL MEMBER** or an **ASSOCIATE MEMBER** of the **MEN'S and LADIES AOH DIVISION 10, LYNN, MA.** who has been a member in good standing for (2) two consecutive years prior to the date of application. Any deceased member's child or grandchild, who applies, has up to 3 years to apply after the member's death.
2. The Ancient Order of Hibernians, Division 10 Scholarship program will be used to aid students accepted to or attending an accredited institution of higher education or a student attending a Catholic parochial high school which is duly accredited.
3. Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of scholastic ability, character and extra-curricular activities and a written essay on why they are applying for a scholarship. **One scholarship will be awarded to a high school student who is enrolled in a Catholic High School. Four scholarships will be awarded to students entering or attending a College or University. Each scholarship is worth \$2000.00**
4. The scholarships will **not** be awarded if, in the judgment of the Scholarship Committee, no applicant is properly qualified.
